Position Type and Term

- Elected by NOVAA membership.
- One year term with reappointment possible.
- Time Commitment: Bi-monthly board meetings (2 hours), plus approximately 5 hours per month, depending on the project.

Goal

Support Committees in their work to position NOVAA as a leader in providing training and professional development opportunities to the volunteer engagement community.

Duties and Responsibilities

Serve as a voting member of the NOVAA Board, serve as a committee member on at least one committee, represent NOVAA to membership and the wider community, and assist with special projects.

Members at large may participate in any number of the following:

- Committee Participation: Lead or serve on board committees such as Board Development, Marketing, Membership, Workshop, and/or Professional Development.
- Special Projects: Lead or provide support for other projects proposed by the Board.
- Liaison: Serve on external committees as representatives of the NOVAA Board (for example, ALIVE Board, Oregon Committee on Volunteerism)
- Serve as a direct liaison to the Board from an organization promoting volunteerism in the region (for example, HandsOn Greater Portland)
- Leadership Development: Shadow a Board member chairing a Committee to train as their replacement.
